Here's How I Use This Form

- 1) Enter the squadron information in the spaces provided.
- 2) Highlight the squadrons assigned to bombers to make it easier to keep track of them.
- 3) Use the large space for remarks and notes.
- 4) Get periodic updates and update the squadron's remaining strength, target status and current location.

Use this in conjunction with a piece of acetate (clear plastic for overhead slides) that is used as an overlay on the tactical map. Using colored Expo Vis-A-Vis® markers, plot the current location of squadrons and where the fights are most intense. It quickly gets messy and erasing the marks is impractical so keep a couple of blank sheets of acetate handy so you can start over when the sheet gets cluttered with too many marks.
